

Policy on Appeal Against Admission Decision

RCSI DEVELOPING HEALTHCARE LEADERS WHO MAKE A DIFFERENCE WORLDWIDE



The purpose of this document is to outline the Admissions Policy in relation to applicants who have not been offered a place and wish to appeal the Admissions Committee's decision.

Only decisions about general and specific entry requirements may be appealed. Late or incomplete applications, cancelled programmes, the shortlisting and interview result or the inability to comply with the HEC regulations do not constitute grounds for an appeal.

Unsuccessful applicants, who wish to appeal the Admissions Committee decision must do so in writing within 14 days of the Admissions Office's initial notification to the applicant.

Appeals must be emailed to the Admissions manager on medicinebahrain@rcsi.com or nursingbahrain@rcsi.com.

Appeals will be assessed by a senior member of RCSI Bahrain staff, who has not been involved in the admissions decision process. The outcome of the appeal will be communicated to the applicant as soon as possible of submission of the appeal. The decision of the appeals outcome is final.

In the event that the appeal is granted, it is not guaranteed that the applicant will be able to join the relevant programme in the same academic year of application. Rather, the candidate might have to wait until the next academic year.
