Master and Bridging Students Medical Screening

In compliance with the Ministry of Health, "Policy for Immunization and Infectious Diseases Screening for Medical, Dental, Nursing, and Physiotherapy Students" and the Higher Education Council requirements, all new Master and Bridging students need to completed the Infectious Disease Screening identified below (A). GCC nationals and residents should complete their Infectious Disease Screening at a Ministry of Health Facility in their country of origin. Results should be recorded on a medical examination certificate, which clearly states the applicant's fitness. Bahraini students should complete their Infectious Disease Screening (Medical Examination Certificate) at their Local Health Centre or a Ministry of Health, approved private hospital .(see list of approved hospitals attached).

A. Infectious Disease Screening Required:

- Hepatitis B Surface Antigen
- Hepatitis B Antibodies
- Hepatitis C Antibody
- HIV 1 & 2
- Tuberculosis Screening (PPD skin test).
- Chest X Ray
