

Statement on Feedback Pertaining to Admission

- The competitive nature of admission to the RCSI means that many good applications are unsuccessful.
 The University does not provide feedback to unsuccessful applicants automatically but will provide written feedback to unsuccessful applicants who submit a written request.
- 2. Requests for feedback for Undergraduate Medicine, should be made to the Undergraduate Admissions Office, medicinebahrain@rcsi.com. Requests for feedback for Undergraduate Nursing and MSc Nursing programmes should be made to nursingbahrain@rcsi.com.
- 3. Feedback will be provided to the applicant only, not to any third party, unless an applicant has given specific permission, in writing, for the third party to act on his/her behalf.
- 4. The University will not enter into discussions with applicants about the academic judgement behind decisions on applications.
- 5. The University maintains an Appeals Procedure.
- 6. Applicants who request feedback, make a complaint, or appeal against an admission decision, will not be disadvantaged in any way in any future applications to RCSI Bahrain.
