

Statement on Fraud Pertaining to Admission

The University reserves the right to cancel an application and withdraw an offer at any time during the admissions process, if it is found that the application contains false or misleading information.

- 1. Applicants proven to have provided false information, relevant to their application will have their application deemed ineligible and will be eliminated from the application process.
- 2. The Student Academic and Regulatory Affairs (Registry) Office may discontinue from the University, any student found to have gained admission through the provision of false or misleading information, or through failing to disclose information that would have materially and adversely affected the determination of the application for admission.

Students discontinued from the University as a consequence of 1 or 2 above will not have an automatic right to a full refund of tuition fees.
