

Authentication of IB Diploma

Before you start make sure that your name in your International Baccalaureate (IB) documents is spelt as per your valid passport. You must retain the same nationality and passport name for the duration of the programme in RCSI Medical University of Bahrain.

What is Authentication of Documents and why is it needed?

Academic qualifications intended for use in another country must be "authenticated" or "legalized" in order to be recognized as valid in that country. The Higher Education Council (HEC) Bahrain requires all students commencing studies in Bahrain to obtain authentication of their High School/Secondary Transcript, Diploma, and Degrees.

Required documents to be submitted to the university

<p>Completed in Bahrain</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Original High School Transcript and Diploma/Certificate stamped by the Ministry of Education – Private Education Directorate • Original IB Transcript and Diploma stamped by the Ministry of Education – Private Education Directorate • Original Equivalency Letter issued by the Ministry of Education – Private Education Directorate (check with your school as they may process this for you)
<p>Completed Outside of Bahrain</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Original IB Transcript and Diploma stamped by the Ministry of Education in the country where the IB Diploma was completed • An Equivalency Letter (where available) <p>Note: If you have completed your studies in the GCC and obtained the Ministry of Education stamp, the below steps are not required.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stamp from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Bahrain Embassy in the country where the IB Diploma was completed • Stamp from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Bahrain and the Embassy in Bahrain of the country in which you have studied. <p>For the last point, we can have them done on your behalf. If you wish to avail of this service, please contact attestbahrain@rcsi-mub.com to get the cost associated.</p>
<p>Alternative Option</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • IB offers an Apostille service, the above can be attested using Apostille. If you are in school, you must request this service through your IB Coordinator <p>Note: Programme coordinators must submit requests to the IB on a student's behalf via IB website. Please submit legalization requests by 15 June for May exam sessions.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you have graduated, you must request this service through the below IB website: https://www.ibo.org/university-admission/support-students-transition-to-higher-education/requesting-and-sending-transcripts/legalization/

- If true copies are attested, the unattested original documents must also be submitted.
